COS 412 WESLEYAN MOVEMENT
Summer Course of Study
June 30-July 25, 2008

About this course:

Using the emergence of the Methodist movement as the context, this course will explore how Wesleyan theological emphases and polity developed. Class members will reflect on the contributions of key historical figures, will seek to discover theological themes in the United Methodist experience, and will relate those learnings to the role of today's pastor.

Course requirements:

- § attend and participate in class
- § give evidence of having completed the assigned readings, including a brief report on a new insight found in Heitzenrater's book
- § prepare essay (no less than 1500 words) on "Sin in the Teachings of the Wesleyan Movement"
- § complete satisfactorily two tests: a brief one at mid-course and a full one toward the end of the course
