Pre-assignments:

Pre-Assignment 1):

Write a short essay (1,000 words) answering the question: What is the Gospel? The purpose of this essay is not to be right or to impress the instructor. The purpose of the essay is give you the opportunity to express, in as succinct a way as possible, how you currently understand the gospel. The essay will not be graded, but it will matter whether it is completed and turned in on time. The essay will be turned in on the first day of class.

Pre-Assignment 2):

Describe in as much detail as possible the way the church where you are currently serving observes the liturgical calendar, the Christian year. Mention every celebration, worship service, etc. that is associated with the church year. (For example, the kids in our Sunday school made pretzels on the first Sunday of Lent because pretzels have been a traditional food for the Lenten fast. If I were writing this essay I would mention this.) Think about questions like: Does your church observe Transfiguration Sunday? Dress in red on Pentecost? Do you have a Lenten Bible study? Hanging of the Greens? The more detailed your description the more helpful this will be to you.

This will not be graded, but it will matter if it is completed and turned in on time. It will be turned in the first day of class.

Pre-Assignment 3)

If you had all the time you wanted to further explore one theme or topic that you encountered in the readings for this course, what theme or topic would it be? Why did this interest you so much? What next step would you take in your further exploration? (This should be short, no more than 300 words). This will not be graded, but it will matter if is completed and turned in on time. It will be turned in the first day of class.
